Title: Local Elections Update followed by the Americans for the Arts Webinar:
Election Update and Arts in the New Federal Administration

Description: Dalouge Smith, San Diego Regional Arts and Culture Coalition Chairperson, will lead a discussion on the impact of the local and state elections on San Diego's arts and culture sector.
